Hiring for Culture? Difficult But Critical

When your company culture fails, it will kill productivity and your profit. Conversely; with the right culture in place, companies seek to perpetuate their enlightenment. They strive to continuing to hire better and smarter. With this principle as a foundation for hiring, new employees require less coaching and supervision! 




