# When is Rehabilitation and Home Health Care beneficial?

**REHABILITATION:** The childhood years through adolescence are vital for the proper growth and development of balance, movement and strength. In childhood physical therapy, we help children develop proper motor functions using special techniques and care.

Home Care can assist with medication management, fall prevention, assessment of quality care in the home setting, resources that can assist in keeping one in their desired home setting for as long as safety allows.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) estimates that home health care agencies in the United States provide care for more than 2.4 million people annually. Common diagnoses among home health care patients include circulatory disease, heart disease, injury, stroke, MS, ALS, weakness, swallowing difficulty and respiratory disease.

## Cutting Through the Cloud of Uncertainty When Hiring

Finding the right candidate for your open position is certainly important. But hiring managers today must employ tools beyond the typical criminal background check, resumé and interview. Hiring an employee is an investment. Make a 'wise investment' and not one that may have to be written off as a loss.

When a job candidate is engaging in the process of trying to land a job, they are "selling themselves". What they say or demonstrate in the selection process may be open and revealing. It may be deceptive. Nevertheless, they want the job! Social media platforms like Facebook, LinkedIn, Instagram and Twitter can be very revealing as to the candidate's true character.

These tools can confirm what the candidates present themselves to be. A profile may not necessarily display red flags or criminal acts, but they may reveal clues of a person's attitude and work ethic. A person's online posts may also confirm an active and healthy social life; supporting the impression that the individual had presented in an interview.



A simple Google search of the person's name can uncover news articles or historical records of employment. And the hiring manager shouldn't stop with the first page of Google results. Negative content may be buried on later pages.

[Angellist](#) is a site that shows a user's work history and is a great indicator of how often a potential hire has changed jobs.

[Quora](#) is a tool that can show how a new recruit's mind works. On Quora, a user answers various questions, and you can review the information and answers the person has posted.

Some 'rejected candidates' may be growing more prudent regarding their otherwise private activities and the influence on their employment chances. One may even consider it as cultural maturing!
