## What Is Occupational Therapy

Unless you or a loved one has received Occupational Therapy, you may wonder “what is Occupational Therapy?”. As the name might erroneously lead you, it is not therapy to help you get a job or occupation. It is the only profession that helps people across the lifespan do the things/ activities they want and need to do through the use of therapeutic activity (occupations). I will further explain the role of OT with the help of the American Occupational Therapy Association.

Occupational Therapists enable people to live life to its fullest by helping them promote health, and prevent or live better with injury, illness or disability. Examples of OT intervention include helping children with disabilities to fully participate in school and social situations, helping people

recovering from injury regain movement and strength while learning new ways to engage in activities of daily living, and providing support and education to older adults who are living with physical and cognitive changes.

Occupational Therapy has a holistic approach that takes into account each individuals’ goals, abilities, past experiences and desire to fully engage in the skill of living. An OT is here to walk with you as life changes occur and provide support, education, environmental adaptation, adaptive techniques and help you achieve goals.

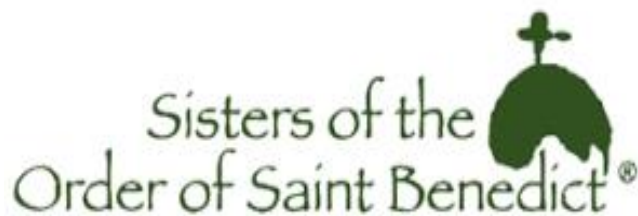

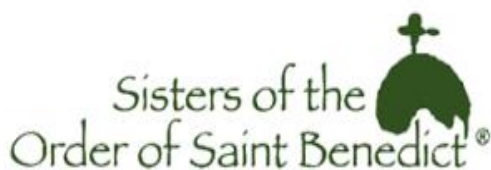
